#### THE COURT OF ARBITRATION FOR SPORT (CAS) HAS OPENED ITS TEMPORARY OFFICE ON THE SITE OF THE 2018 COMMONWEALTH GAMES

*Lausanne, 3 April 2018* – The Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) has opened a temporary office in Gold Coast, Australia, to resolve any legal disputes arising during the 2018 Commonwealth Games (the Games).

The office will be operational until 15 April 2018, the day of the Closing Ceremony, and is headed by the CAS Secretary General, Mr Matthieu Reeb.

It is the sixth time that the CAS is present on the site of the Commonwealth Games and applies a specific expedited procedure, which can be initiated by any participant in the Games with the filing of an application form.
