CAS AD HOC DIVISION OLYMPIC GAMES RIO 2016

ATHLETICS: DARYA KLISHINA (RUSSIA) CHALLENGES THE IAAF DECISION TO DECLARE HER INELIGIBLE TO COMPETE AT THE OLYMPIC GAMES IN RIO BEFORE THE CAS AD HOC DIVISION

Rio de Janeiro, 13 August 2016 – The ad hoc Division of the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) at the Olympic Games Rio 2016 registered today an application filed by the Russian athlete Darya Klishina (long jump) against the decision declaring her ineligible to compete in international competitions, including the athletics competition at the Olympic Games 2016, rendered by the Doping Review Board of the International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) on 12 August 2016.

The IAAF (Respondent), as well as the Russian Olympic Committee (ROC) and the International Olympic Committee (IOC), as interested parties, have been invited to participate in this arbitration procedure. The CAS ad hoc Division will examine this case tomorrow and will endeavour to render a final decision on Sunday 14 August 2016, before midnight.

The full award with the grounds will be published on the CAS website as soon as it will be available.
