Bruno De Vita, QC is Alexander Holburn's Managing Partner. Mr. De Vita has also acted for professionals, including lawyers, real estate agents, insurance brokers and psychologists in both liability and disciplinary matters. He has acted as defence counsel in a number of civil cases dealing with allegations of sexual abuse and vicarious liability for sexual abuse and has acted for religious institutions in actions involving alleged liability of church officials.
