INTERNATIONAL SKI FEDERATION (FIS) ELECTIONS

THE COURT OF ARBITRATION FOR SPORT (CAS) REGISTERS THE APPEAL FILED BY THE SKI FEDERATIONS OF AUSTRIA, GERMANY, CROATIA AND SWITZERLAND

Lausanne, 23 June 2022 – The Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) has registered the appeal filed by the ski federations of Austria, Germany, Croatia and Switzerland against the election of Mr Johan Eliasch as President of the International Ski Federation (FIS) at the 2022 FIS Congress held on 26 May 2022 (the Challenged Decision).

The four national federations seek the annulment of the Challenged Decision on the grounds that the election was faulty.

A CAS arbitration has commenced. The parties will exchange written submissions while an Arbitral Panel is appointed to decide the matter. It is for the Panel, once appointed, to issue directions with respect to a hearing. At this time, it is not possible to indicate when the final decision will be issued.
