FIFA PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

CAS REJECTS JEROME CHAMPAGNE'S REQUEST FOR URGENT PROVISIONAL MEASURES

Lausanne, 25 February 2016 – The Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) has today rejected an urgent request for provisional measures filed by FIFA Presidential election candidate Jerome Champagne.

On 24 February 2016, Jerome Champagne filed an appeal at the CAS against a decision issued by the FIFA Ad-hoc Electoral Committee dated 17 February 2016, together with an urgent request for provisional measures seeking an order from the CAS that FIFA be directed, inter alia, to use transparent voting booths and independent scrutineers to safeguard the integrity of the voting process and to ensure that the vote is conducted in secret.

The request for provisional measures was rejected by the President of the CAS Appeals Arbitration Division. The full order with grounds will be communicated in a few days.
