

# **Luis A. Breuer, LL.M.**

## **Brief Resume**

Luis A. Breuer has a Master's in Law Degree (LL.M.) from Harvard Law School. He is a senior partner and manager of the Paraguay office of the Latin American law firm *Aguilar Castillo Love* ([www.aguilarcastillolove.com](http://www.aguilarcastillolove.com)) with offices throughout Central and South America. He specialized in the areas of foreign investment, international business transactions, corporate law, international arbitration, energy, M&A, agribusiness, telecoms, mining, banking and finance, trusts and securities markets.

During his 25 years of professional career, he has advised several Fortune 500 companies and other multinationals and counseled governmental agencies and represented clients of the public and private sector in projects financed by multilateral organizations such as the World Bank, IDB, IFC, OPIC, among others. He also collaborates in publications of some of these organizations.

Throughout his career, he has been involved in highly complex cross-border transactions. His practice includes advising national and international companies on international trade, business transactions and in their investments.

One of the key areas of Luis's expertise relates to the sale and distribution of goods and services, and he has advised multinational companies such as American Express, Molson Coors, Apple, HP, J&J, Google, BMW, Mapfre, Sanofi, among others.

In the field of arbitration. I have been a member of the International Court of Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC Paris) (2013-2021); part of the list of arbitrators of the International Centre for the Settlement of Investment Disputes (ICSID) for a second term (2018-2024); arbitrator of the Court of Arbitration of Sports (TAS/CAS), where he has participated in several seminars and training sessions; and the CEITAC.

Breuer has acted as counsel and advisor and served as arbitrator in local and international commercial arbitrations, in different areas including international trade, distribution law; services contracts; construction contracts, agribusiness and finance.

Breuer has been a speaker and assisted to various congresses and seminars in Paraguay, in the region, Europe and North America, and has been a member of the ABA, the IBA, and of the Dispute Resolution Section of the latter.

He has been contributor and author in chapters, and has written legal articles on international arbitration, foreign investment, distribution law, ITBs, jurisdiction and public order, structured finance, energy, trusts and corporate matters.

In 2012, Luis Breuer was appointed as Ambassador and Permanent Representative for Paraguay at the Latin-American Integration (ALADI) and Mercosur (Common Market

of the Southern Cone) in Montevideo, Uruguay. As member of the Permanent Commission of Representatives of ALADI and MERCOSUR, he negotiated a series of multilateral trade and investment agreements between the members states.

From 2013 to 2018, Breuer held the most relevant legal positions in the energy sector of Paraguay, first being appointed as the Head Legal Counsel of Yacyreta Binational Entity (the hydro-energy facility owned by Paraguay and Argentina), and in 2014, as the Executive Legal Director and Member of the Board of Itaipu Binacional, the largest producer of hydro-energy in the world, owned by Paraguay and Brasil, and the most valuable strategic asset of Paraguay.
