One of his most significant achievements is leading the State of Montenegro to seven major arbitration wins, five in investor-state arbitrations and two in high-value and high-complexity commercial arbitrations. In various instances, Slaven successfully advised and represented the national federations, clubs and athletes, including before the sport resolution bodies such as FIBA and BAT. He is also an arbitrator on the list of arbitrators of the Permanent Arbitration at the Serbian Chamber of Commerce, as well as the list of arbitration practitioners with the Vienna International Arbitration Centre.
