Political and legal activities related to football.

In 2016, he was appointed by the Board of Directors of Club Atlético Peñarol as one of the three delegates representing Club Atlético Peñarol before the Uruguayan Football Association (AUF). During his tenure, he has led the defense in disciplinary proceedings against several sports professionals and club members before the AUF Disciplinary Committee and the South American Football Confederation (CONMEBOL). The Board of Directors of Club Atlético Peñarol, under the Presidency of Dr. Jorge Barrera, appointed him as the **Institution's Delegate to the Uruguayan Football Association (AUF)** in 2017.



He was a full member of the **Board of Directors of Club Atlético Peñarol** (2020-2023 term) and an alternate member of the Board of Directors (2017-2020 term); a full member of the Representative Assembly of Club Atlético Peñarol (2011-2013 term), elected by the Espacio Siglo XXI group; for the 2014-2017 term, he was elected a full member of the Representative Assembly by the Sentimiento 1891 group, and for the 2018-2021 term by the Espacio Siglo XXI group. **He was an active member of the Peñarol Athletic Club Regulations Reform Commission (drafting the current regulations) and has served on various commissions within the Uruguayan Football Association (AUF)**, including those related to the Player Statute, the Disciplinary Code Reform, and the current Statute Reform.

In May 2019, he was appointed to the **Executive Committee of the Uruguayan Football Association (AUF)**, serving as Vice President.

Since 2020, he has been a member of the **CONMEBOL Stakeholders Committee** and has participated in various commissions and working groups. He has also represented the AUF as a Delegate at the 72nd FIFA Congress in Doha, Qatar; the 73rd FIFA Congress in Kigali, Rwanda; and the 75th CONMEBOL Ordinary Congress in Doha, Qatar.

He has collaborated and worked as a **COORDINATOR between CONMEBOL, the Uruguayan Football Association (AUF), and the Uruguayan government in organizing the single-match finals of the CONMEBOL Sudamericana and CONMEBOL Libertadores Cups**, held in Montevideo in November 2021.



He also **spearheaded the organization of the first edition of the Intercontinental Cup (Under-20), played in Montevideo in August 2022, sponsored by UEFA and CONMEBOL**

He is currently an **arbitrator representing CONMEBOL (Uruguay) at the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS).**

He has been appointed as a **member of the FIFA Football Association's Chamber of Football Agents, representing CONMEBOL.** In 2023, he worked on the Organizing Committee for the 2023 CONMEBOL Sudamericana Cup Single Final, as **President of the Local Organizing Committee**, which was held in Maldonado, Uruguay, in November 2023.

He is currently **Honorary President and Vice President of Club Frontera Rivera in Uruguay.**

He is currently President of the Club Rampla Juniors F.C. (Soriano Futbol Club SAD) in Uruguay since December 2024.

Professionally, he has advised and participated in litigation for Club Atlético Peñarol, Club Frontera Rivera, Central Español Futbol Club, Racing Club de Montevideo, Rampla Juniors Futbol Club, and La Luz Fútbol Club SAD.

Personal and Academic Background



He was born in Montevideo on June 2, 1975. He attended preschool, primary, and secondary school at Elbio Fernández School and High School. He entered the Law-Notary career in 1994 at the Faculty of Law of the University of the Republic (UDELAR).

He is a lawyer and holds a Doctorate in Law and Social Sciences from the University of the Republic (UDELAR).

He is a graduate of the Uruguayan Association of Public Relations (AURP), having obtained the titles of Technician, Consultant, and Manager (at the Bachelor's level) in Public Relations in 1992, 1993, and 1994.

He has taught Social and Civic Education at the Immaculate Conception School and High School and was a member of the Chair of Public International Law at the University of the Republic (UDELAR) from 2001 to 2006.

He has completed postgraduate studies in “International Responsibility,” “Legal Aspects of Regional Integration,” and “International Humanitarian Law.”

In the student union sphere, he has served on the Law School Council, representing the Student Body as a full member (1997-1999 and 1999-2001 terms), the Law School Assembly as a full member (1995-1997), and the UDELAR General Assembly as a full member (1997-1999). He was also elected First Secretary and a member of the Coordinating Secretariat of the Law Students' Center for several terms from 1994 to 2001.



He has organized and chaired Organizing Committees for various Congresses and Seminars, both in Uruguay and abroad, and has participated in delegations representing the Federation of University Students (FEUU) in Cuba in 1997 and the National Youth Institute (INJU) in Lisbon in 1998.

He was also appointed by the Law School Council to various advisory committees as a representative of that body before various national and international organizations and congresses.

In the field of sports, he has participated in numerous events and has taught courses on sports law and money laundering applied to sports at the University of the Republic (UDELAR), the Bank of the Eastern Republic of Uruguay, and the University of Montevideo (UM).

He is a **member of the Uruguay Section of the World Compliance Association, an active member, and a member of its Fiscal Commission.**

He is also a **member of the Uruguayan Bar Association**, and by letter dated April 18, 2018, he was notified of his unanimous admission by the **Board of Directors of the Society of Friends of Popular Education (SAEP), as an Active Member with full rights**, a position he holds to this day.
