Hans Nater, born in 1943, is the senior partner with Nater Dallafior Rechtsanwälte, Zurich. He graduated from the University of Zurich in 1970 and wrote a doctoral thesis in the area of product liability. He was admitted to the Bar in 1972. In 1973, he received his LLM from Harvard Law School.

After graduating from Harvard Law School, Hans Nater practiced law in New York and, in 1975, founded the law firm Stiffler & Nater, Zurich, which he left after 30 years in order to become one of the founding partners of Nater Dallafior Rechtsanwälte, a firm focusing on representing domestic and international clients in complex proceedings before state courts, administrative bodies and arbitral tribunals, including the co-ordination of disputes in different jurisdictions.

Hans Nater is a litigation and arbitration specialist.

Hans Nater is an arbitrator at the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) and on the list of Swiss ICC Arbitrators. He has served as a member of the CAS ad hoc Division at the 2002, 2004 and 2006 Olympic Games in Salt Lake City, Athens and Torino respectively and as an arbitrator of the Claims Resolution Tribunal for Dormant Accounts in Switzerland (CRT). He was President of the Zürich Bar Association and Vice-President of the Swiss Olympic Committee.

Hans Nater's published writing includes works on professional legal services, product liability, corporate governance and telecommunications.
